

- A corn law was set by Britain during 1840's, when the landowners who dominated Parliament, wanted to protect their farms by imposing a duty o imported corn. The corn law stated "no cheap wheat(corn) would be imported to compete with British farmers".
- As a result of that, these corn laws created a major starvation, people had to pay higher prices of bread. So, they cancelled the event. Britain traded freely without any taxes. They repealed the law, and the prices of bread reduced. Thanks to of course, <u>SIR</u> <u>ROBERT PEEL</u> the new prime minister and his government for repealing the law.

### HOW DID REPEALING THE CORN LAWS MOVE COLONIES INTO FORMING CANADA:

-The repeal of the corn laws had a major effect on politics in Canada. Since Britain was trading more freely with other countries, it no longer relied on much trade with it's colonies, so it no longer felt the need to control politics in the colonies. Britain was willing to let **British North America** take care of it own affairs under a system of good government.
